WHAT IS TAMIS?

The Tax Administration Management Information System (TAMIS) is a new online integrated tax platform from the Barbados Revenue Authority which provides more efficient, accurate and user-friendly services for taxpayers.

ALL EMPLOYEES, SELF-EMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS AND PENSIONERS IN RECEIPT OF PENSION OVER \$40,000 A YEAR, MUST RE-REGISTER IN TAMIS FOR A NEW TAX IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (TIN) & TO HAVE THEIR PAYMENTS & REFUNDS PROCESSED. IF YOU FILED AN INCOME TAX RETURN IN THE PAST YOU MUST RE-REGISTER.

WHAT YOU NEED TO RE-REGISTER FOR YOUR INCOME TAX

Individuals require the following to complete their Re-Registration:

- Scanned copy or photo of your National Identification Card (Max. file size is 2MB)
- Email address (You MUST have access to this email)
- · Bank account details

- Current TIN or National Registration Number
- Access to your ETAX account (in order to answer the security question)
- Tax agent TIN (optional)

HOW TO RE-REGISTER?

Click "Register Now" & follow Go to https://tamis.bra.gov.bb directions to create your account An "Activation successful" message will appear and you will receive You will receive an activation email. Click the link in the email another email with your username Once logged in, you will need to complete three simple security Log into the TAMIS website with your **username** and **password** questions On the "Registration type" page Click "OK" on the Account choose "I am an authorised person configuration page & then click or agent re-registering an individual 8 "Register New Taxpayer" taxpayer already registered in eTax or VETAS"

On the "Personal Details" page, choose January 1, 2018 as your Commencement date. Complete the registration form and click "Submit Application"

A "Confirmation" message will appear with your Registration Case Reference Number eg. REG1059. It will also be sent to your email
