### OPTION 1 ONLINE & TELEPHONE ORDERING

- Orders will be taken by the individual participating supermarkets via telephone, WhatsApp or email.
- Payment for these orders will be accepted through cash, debit or credit cards.
- Persons can collect their groceries:
  1. In person at a specific collection time **OR**
  2. Curbside vehicle pick up at a specific collection time **OR**
  3. Home delivery

Specific collection times are given to eliminate the possibility of gatherings that contravene the requirement for physical distancing. *Try to be on time!*

Please note that many retailers already have a sizeable backlog of orders for delivery and this may slow down the pace of delivery.

*Be considerate. If you already have adequate supplies, allow others to acquire their essential items.*

### OPTION 2 WALK-UP ORDERING OF PRE-PACKAGED BASKETS

AVAILABLE ONLY AT CHANELS, TRIMART, POPULAR,  
SAVINGS MART AND JORDANS SUPERMARKETS

- Shoppers will be able to see a list of items in each basket ahead of placing and paying for their orders.
- Baskets will be in values of **\$25, \$50, \$100 & \$150**
- The contents are determined by the individual retailers, based on their examination of the shopping patterns of their customers.

*This approach will not necessarily facilitate the personal taste, brand choices or shopping volumes however, the primary mission is to ensure everyone has an adequate supply of what they need, while keeping the country safe by containing the spread of COVID-19.*
